Uruguay

If you've danced tango in Argentina and partied at Carnival in Brazil but skipped neighboring Uruguay, you've missed out. Though small in size, Uruguay has such a range of options for all kinds of travelers that it's a mystery that it has stayed off the radar for North American travelers for so long.

The glitzy Atlantic Coast resort of Punta Del Este (often nicknamed "St. Tropez of South America") is famous amongst the South American and European jet set for its nightlife and beaches. In stark contrast to the glamour of Punta, the Rocha region, around two hours north, boasts bohemian beach towns and a laid-back attitude. Looking for something in between?
